

CORPORATION OF Westmeath

BY-LAW NO. 82-9

WHEREAS subsection 7 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act (RSO. 1980, c.198) as amended provides that:

The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by bylaw designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies;

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of ~~certain~~ highways in the Corporation of

the Township of Westmeath and therefore the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act apply to the highways ~~named hereunder~~ during the period from the 1st day of February to the 31st day of May inclusive in each and every year.
2. This bylaw shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.

BY-LAW NO.

A BY-LAW TO DESIGNATE A REDUCED LOAD PERIOD ON COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS the Highway Traffic Act, Chapter 198, section 104a, subsection 7, R.S.O. 1980, as amended, provides that:

"The municipal corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway may by by-law designate the date on which a reduced load period shall start or end and the highway or portion thereof under its jurisdiction to which the designation applies."

AND WHEREAS the reduced load period is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways in the Corporation of the County of Renfrew;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the County of Renfrew enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of subsections 1, 2, 3 and 4 of section 104a of the Highway Traffic Act apply to the highways named hereunder during the period from the 1st day of February to the 31st day of May inclusive in each and every year.
Highways - All highways which are designated as County Roads.
2. This by-law shall not become effective until appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
3. County of Renfrew By-Law No. 1376 passed on October 13th, 1944 is hereby repealed.

READ a first time this 10th day of March, 1982.

READ a second time this 10th day of March, 1982.

READ a third time and finally passed this 10th day of March, 1982.
