

BY-LAW NO. 82-16

The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath.

Being a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year, and to set the rates of taxation for the year 1982.

Whereas the Council of the Township of Westmeath has, in accordance with the Municipal Act, considered the estimates of the municipality and the various Boards of the municipality, and it is necessary to raise the following sums by taxation in 1982:

Public School	136,464
Secondary School	138,921
Separate School	26,475
Westmeath Street Lights	2,678
Lapasse Street Lights	798

And whereas the Assessment Roll made in 1981 for taxation in 1982 as revised shows the following assessments for the bodies concerned:

Therefore the Council of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

1. That the estimates be adopted and the above mentioned amounts be levied in the manner set out hereinafter.
2. That there shall be levied and collected upon the assessment of the lands, buildings and businesses within the Corporation the following rates for 1982:

3. That 1982 taxes will be payable in two instalments with due dates to be 20 July, 1982 and 20 November, 1982.
4. That unpaid taxes will be subject to a 4% penalty charge plus an interest rate of 1.25% per month after the due date.
5. That this by-law shall come into effect upon the date of final reading.

NOTICE OF APPLICATION to the Ontario Municipal Board by the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath for approval of a By-law to regulate land use passed pursuant to Section 39 of The Planning Act.

TAKE NOTICE that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath intends to apply to the Ontario Municipal Board pursuant to the provisions of Section 39 of The Planning Act for approval of By-law No. 82-17 passed on the 10th day of May, 1982. A copy of the By-law is furnished herewith.

ANY PERSON INTERESTED MAY, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Westmeath notice of his objection to approval of the said By-law, or any part thereof giving details of all or the portion of the By-law to which you object and detailed reasons therefor, and shall indicate that, if a hearing is held, the objector or an agent will attend at the hearing to support the objection.

ANY PERSON wishing to support the application for approval of the By-law may, within twenty-one (21) days after the date of this Notice, send by registered mail or deliver to the Clerk of the Township of Westmeath notice of his support of approval of the said By-law, together with a request for notice of any hearing that may be held giving also the name and address to which such notice should be given.

THE ONTARIO MUNICIPAL BOARD may approve of the said By-law, but before doing so it may appoint a time and place when any objections to the By-law will be considered. Notice of any hearing that may be held will be given only to persons who have filed an objection or notice of support and who have left with or delivered to the Clerk undersigned, the address to which notice of hearing is to be sent, and similarly, to any person who filed a request for a change in the provisions of the By-law.

THE LAST DATE FOR FILING OBJECTIONS WILL BE JUNE 2, 1982.
