

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

BY-LAW NO. 84-10

Being a by-law to adopt the estimates of all sums required during the year, and to set the rates of taxation for the year 1984.

Whereas the Council of the Township of Westmeath has, in accordance with the Municipal Act, considered the estimates of the municipality and the various Boards of the municipality, and it is necessary to raise the following sums by taxation in 1984.

And whereas the Assessment Roll made in 1983 for taxation in 1984 as revised shows the following assessments for the bodies concerned:

Therefore the Council of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

1. That the estimates be adopted and the above mentioned amounts be levied in the manner set out hereinafter.
2. That there shall be levied and collected upon the assessment of the lands, buildings and businesses within the Corporation the following rates for 1984:

3. That 1984 taxes will be payable in two instalments, with due dates to be 31 July, 1984 and 30 November 1984.
