

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

BY-LAW NO. 87-10

A By-law to amend By-law 86-23, a by-law prohibiting the obstructing or encumbering of highways and bridges.

Whereas the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath has passed a by-law prohibiting the obstructing, encumbering, injuring or fouling of highways and bridges, being By-law 86-23


And whereas, in order to have the penalties for contravention of the by-law recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act, it is necessary to change the set fines laid out in Section 3 of By-law 86-23.

Now therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath enacts as follows:

1 Section 3 of By-Law 86-23 be removed in its entirety and replaced with the following:-

"Any person who contravenes any terms of this by-law shall pay a fine not less than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$ 100.00) and not more than THREE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$ 300.00), exclusive of costs, and all penalties shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act."
