

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

BY-LAW 93-10

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE NO PARKING OF VEHICLES ON FIRE ROUTES.


- WHEREAS: 1. Under Section 210(52)(131)(a) a Municipality is authorized to design a fire route and to erect no-parking, tow-away-zone signs.
2. Vehicles shall be removed and impounded at the owner's expense.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath ENACTS as follows:

1. The Corporation of the Township of Westmeath is authorized to erect signs and designate fire routes at the Dry Fire Hydrants at the wharf in the Hamlet of Westmeath, at the wharf in the Hamlet of LaPasse and at the Little Lake. There shall be no parking between signs.
2. Vehicles parked in the no-parking zone shall be towed away at the owner's expense.
3. The By-Law Enforcement Officer or in his absence, the Fire Chief or his deputy shall be authorized to contact a towing company to have the vehicle, that is contravening this by-law, removed at the owner's expense.

This By-Law shall come into effect at the date of passing.
