

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WESTMEATH

BY-LAW 98-18

A By-Law to Restrict Speed of Motor Vehicles on Certain Highways

WHEREAS:

1. Under Section 128, subsection 1 of the Highway Traffic Act, no person shall drive a motor vehicle at a rate of speed greater than 80 kilometres per hour, on a highway not within a city, town, village or built-up area.
2. A Municipality has authority under Section 128, subsection 2 of the Highway Traffic Act to pass a by-law to prescribe a rate of speed different from the rate set out in subsection (1) on highways under its jurisdiction.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed of motor vehicles on the certain highways or portions of certain highways within the Township of Westmeath be restricted.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Westmeath ENACTS as follows:-


1. Where any highway or portion of highway set out below is marked in compliance with the regulations under the Highway Traffic Act, the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be 50 kilometres per hour.

<u>Township Road</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>
Faught Road	Cornerview Road	Pentecostal Camp

2. The penalties provided in subsection 14 of Section 128 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
3. This by-law shall not come into effect until approved by the Ministry of Transportation.
