

**CORPORATION OF THE
TOWNSHIP OF WHITEWATER REGION**

BY-LAW NUMBER 00-10-03

**BEING A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH THE INAUGURAL COUNCIL MEETINGS OF
THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITEWATER REGION.**

WHEREAS pursuant to Section 55 of the *Municipal Act, Chapter M.45, R.S.O. 1990*, every Council shall adopt a procedural by-law for governing the calling, place and proceedings of meetings;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 102 of the *Municipal Act, Chapter M.45, R.S.O. 1990*, every Council may pass such by-laws and make such regulations for governing the conduct of its Members;

AND WHEREAS Council has from time to time enacted by-laws for the good order of Council and said by-laws have been amended from time to time as Council deemed it expedient;


AND WHEREAS Council now deems it expedient to pass a new by-law establishing the date and times for the inaugural Council meetings of the newly created Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region that:

1. a) The Inaugural Council Meeting of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region shall be held on January 2, 2001 at 12:00 p.m. at the Township Administration Building, 44 Main Street Cobden.
b) The agenda for the meeting shall be according to section 16 of Bylaw 00-10-04 "Procedural Bylaw".
2. a) The first Regular Council Meeting of the Township of Whitewater Region shall be held on January 17, 2001 at 7:00 p.m. at the Township Administration Building, 44 Main Street Cobden.
b) The agenda for the first Regular Council Meeting shall be in accordance with Section 18 of Bylaw 00-10-04 "Procedural Bylaw".
3. This Bylaw will supercede bylaw 00-10-04 Sections 4 and 5 for the month January 2001 only. Following the conclusion of the above mentioned meetings this bylaw will be repealed and the all sections of bylaw 00-10-04 will adhered to.
4. All proceedings for these meeting will be in accordance with Bylaw 00-10-04

READ a first time, a second time and finally passed this third reading this 30 day of October, 2000.
