

The Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region

By-law Number 17-01-919

Being a by-law to appoint Fence Viewers, Livestock Valuers, Fire Wardens and Poundkeepers for the Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region

Whereas, Section 5 of the Municipal Act, 2001 S.O. 2001, c.25 as amended states that the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by its Council and generally through by-law; and

Whereas, Section 11(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001 confers authority to pass by-laws respecting the protection of persons and property; and

Whereas, Section 2 of the Line Fences Act R.S.O. 1990, c. L.17 requires the appointment of Fence Viewers; and

Whereas, the Pounds Act R.S.O. 1990 c. P.17 speaks to the responsibilities of the Poundkeeper; and

Whereas, Section 9(a) of the Order in Council establishing the Ontario Wildlife Damage Compensation Program allows municipalities to appoint Municipal Livestock Valuers;

Whereas, Council deems it expedient and necessary to appoint certain officials to serve at the pleasure of Council;

Now therefore Council of the Corporation of the Township of Whitewater Region enacts as follows:

1. That the following individuals are appointed as Fence Viewers:

Dale Bennett	Ray Campbell
Richard Kenny	Jim Tripp
2. That Bruce Bromley is appointed as Municipal Livestock Valuer.
3. That Keith Bennett and Renfrew Pontiac Livestock are appointed as Poundkeepers.
4. That Daryl McLaughlin and Vincent Gervais are appointed as Fire Wardens.
5. That the following rate of pay will apply:
 - 4.1 Livestock Valuer: \$20.00 per hour, minimum of two hours, plus expenses
 - 4.2 Fence Viewers: \$40.00 per day, plus expenses
6. That By-law 17-01-912 is hereby repealed.
7. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect upon being passed by Council.

Read a first, second and third time and finally passed this 18th day of January, 2017.
