A Bylaw to incorporate the village of
Cobden

Whereas the Census returns of the unincorporated
village of Cobden with its immediate neighborhood
taken under the direction of this Council show that
the same contains over 750 inhabitants and that the
residences of such inhabitants are sufficiently near to form
an incorporated Village

And whereas over one hundred resident freeholders
and tenants of the said village and neighborhood of the
age of twenty one years and over, of whom more than one
half are freeholders, have petitioned for the erection of
the village and neighborhood into an incorporated village
and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition

Therefore the Council of the Corporation of the County
of Renfrew hereby enacts as follows:—

1. From and after the passing of this bylaw the unincorporated
Village of Cobden with its immediate
neighborhood shall be an incorporated Village apart
from the Township of Ross, by the name of The Village
of Cobden, and with the following boundaries: the
whole of Lot number Four in the First Concession
of the Township of Ross containing 234 acres, the whole
of Lot number Five in the First Concession of the
said Township of Ross containing 215 acres and
that part of Lot number Six in the First Concession
of the said Township of Ross, commencing at a point on
the Proof line between lots numbers five and six, on the
northern side of the Canadian Pacific Railway at a distance
of thirteen chains and thirty three links from the inter-
section of the said proof line by the said Canadian
Pacific Railway, thence south easterly at right angles
to said proof line a distance of seven chains and
eleven links, thence south westerly and parallel
to said proof line to northern boundary of the said
Canadian Pacific Railway, thence westerly along the

Northern boundary of the said Canadian Pacific Railway, to said plot of land as laid down in the original plat of the Township of Ross by John McNaughton P.L.S., and registered in the Registry Office of the County of Renfrew, containing ten acres, making a total area of 459 acres be the same more or less.

2 The next election for a Reeve and four Councillors for the said Village shall be held at the said Village of Cobden on the date by Law provided, and Joseph R. Mabee of the said Village shall be the returning Officer to hold the same.
