

Bylaw No 318

A Bylaw for the purpose of fixing a time and place for ~~the~~ taking a vote on the Bylaw to raise by way of Debentures the sum of 4000 £ for the purpose therein set forth.

Whereas it is expedient to fix by Bylaw the time and place for the taking of the vote on Bylaw No 317. for the purpose as therein set forth. Therefore the Municipal Council of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows.

- 1) That the vote be taken in Daniels Hall on Feb 17th 1919 from nine o'clock am. to five o'clock p.m.
- 2) That the following persons be and are hereby appointed as municipal officers for the taking of the same.
G.A. Parr Deputy R.O. and James Pever Poll clerk.
- 3) That on Monday the 10th Feb 1919 at the hour of two o'clock in the afternoon at the office of the Clerk the Return shall appoint in writing if demanded two persons to attend the final summing up of the votes by the Clerk and one person to attend the poll at each polling place on behalf of the persons interested in and desirous of promoting the passing of the Bylaw and one person on behalf of the persons interested and desirous of opposing the passing of the Bylaw.
- 4) That the Clerk shall attend at his office at two o'clock in the afternoon of Tuesday the 18th day of Feb 1919 to sum up the votes given for and against the Bylaw.
- 5) That a synopsis of or the Bylaw shall be published in the "Sun" once a week for 3 successive weeks

6) That the clerk is hereby instructed to find and publish the necessary legal notices and to hold the vote as directed by the statutes.
