

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO. 835.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden has approved the construction of a water supply system at a cost of \$81,000., the monies for which are to be raised upon the sale of debentures to be issued, secured on the credit of the Corporation;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the said Village has approved the improvement, and construction of a sewerage system at a cost of \$21,100. the monies for which are to be raised upon debentures to be issued secured on the credit of the corporation;

AND WHEREAS the Council has promulgated two by-laws, one by-law for each of the aforesaid purposes;

AND WHEREAS the Council desire that the persons qualified to vote on money by-laws shall give their assent to the said works and to issue debentures therefor as aforesaid;

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

1. That the votes of the persons qualified to vote on money by-laws be taken on the same date as, the same places where and by the same deputy returning officers as shall be appointed for the taking of the next municipal vote for the election of Councillors and Reeve.

2. The Clerk shall be the The Returning Officer for the taking of the said vote and the clerk shall sum up the number of votes for and against the two by-laws promulgated for each of the purposes aforesaid at the same time when and at the same place where the Clerk shall sum up the votes upon the said municipal election.

3. IN THE EVENT that a municipal election shall not be necessary, the said vote on the by-laws shall be taken on Monday, the fifth day of December, 1949, between the hours of 9 o'clock in the forenoon and 7 o'clock in the afternoon at the polling Booth situate in the in the Memorial Hall in the said Village and the Clerk shall be the Returning officer and preside in the role of deputy returning officer at the polling booth and sum up the number of votes for and against the respective by-laws immediately after the said hour of 7 o'clock at the polling booth aforesaid.

4. In the event that the Clerk shall be unable to act, a deputy returning officer or substitute shall hold and exercise all powers herein conferred on the said Returning officer.

5. There shall be a separate ballot for each of the by-laws aforesaid in the following forms.
