

Bylaw #845

A bylaw for the appointment of Village Policeman, Assessor, Collector, Foreman, Truant Officer and Fire Marshall and Inspector.

Whereas it is expedient to provide by bylaw for the appointment of Policeman, Assessor, Collector, Foreman, Truant Officer and Fire Marshall and Inspector.

Therefore the following individual is hereby appointed to fulfill this position, under the following conditions and duties specified herein.

- 1 To be employed until fifteen days notice be given by employer or ~~by~~ employee.
- 2 That he appear in uniform, provided by Village at all times when on duty.
- 3 That he may set his own hours providing that the equivalent of eight hours per day be spent on his duties.
- 4 That he file monthly report with Clerk covering all phases of his duties and those of the Village Maintenance man.
- 5 That all uniforms and equipment and records will remain Village property.
- 6 After one year employment he will receive one week vacation with pay; two years employment or more he will receive two weeks vacation with pay.
- 7 Dog taxes and Poll taxes and all licenses to be collected on or before April 1st of each year.
- 8 As Village Foreman he will oversee the work of the Village Maintenance man and will fill out his own time card and check and approve the time cards of the Village Maintenance and those of any other person employed by the Village.
- 9 He will be subject to and will receive his orders at all times from the committees having jurisdiction over the various phases of his duties.

Mr. Weldon E. Prendergast is hereby appointed to fulfill the above mentioned offices at an annual salary of fifteen hundred and ten dollars to be paid monthly. Also the annual sum of ninety dollars as an employee of the Cobden Hydro Electric System.
