

By-Law # 863.

A By-law for fixing a time and place for holding a nomination meeting and for polling and for providing for certain municipal officers.

Whereas it is expedient to provide by by-law for the fixing of a time and place for holding a election meeting for the receiving of nominations for Reeve and Councillors and School Trustees and for polling for same and for appointing certain municipal officers

Therefore the municipal Council of the Village of Cobden do enact as follows.

That the meeting for the receiving of nominations for Reeve and Councillors and School Trustees shall be held in the Memorial Hall on Monday the fourth day of December 1950 from the hour of Seven thirty p.m. to the hour of Eight thirty p.m.

That in case a poll be demanded such poll shall be held in Memorial Hall on Monday the Eleventh day of December 1950 from the hour of Eleven o'clock P.M. to the hour of Seven o'clock P.M.

That the following persons are hereby appointed to act as municipal officers

D.P.O. - J. Sammon

Poll Clerk - Donald Appleton

That the Clerk is hereby instructed to give and publish the necessary notices and to hold the meetings as above set out at the time and places mentioned and in such manner directed by the Council of Cobden.
