By-Law No.

A by-law to prohibit unusual noises after 11 o'clock in the evening.

Be it enacted, and it is hereby enacted by the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden, as follows:-

1. That from and after eleven o'clock in the evening all ringing of bells, blowing of horns, shouting, screaming and other unusual noises, or noises calculated to disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Cobden, are hereby prohibited.
2. Any person convicted of a breach of any of the provisions of this by-law shall forfeit and pay at the discretion of the convicting Magistrate or Justice of the Peace, a penalty not exceeding Ten Dollars exclusive of costs and such costs as the Magistrate or Justice of the Peace may impose and the said Magistrate or Justice of the Peace may by his conviction order and adjudge that in default of payment of such penalty imposed by him and costs, if the conviction is made with costs, forthwith or within a limited time, such penalty and costs, if any shall be levied by distress and sale of the goods and chattels of the Offender and if sufficient distress cannot be found, that the Offenders be imprisoned in the common goal of the County of Renfrew, with or without hard labour for any period not exceeding twenty-one days, unless the said penalty and costs, if any, including the costs of the said distress and of the committal and conveying of the Offender are sooner paid.
3. This by-law shall come into force and effect on the passing thereof.

By-Law No.
