

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1951 EXPENDITURE ON ROADS OR STREETS

IN THE TOWN VILLAGE OF Cobden IN THE COUNTY DISTRICT OF PENFREW

WHEREAS under Part IV C of The Highway Improvement Act a by-law to provide for expenditure on roads or streets may be submitted annually to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the council of the corporation of the said town-village enacts as follows:

- (1) The sum of \$ 3600.00 is hereby appropriated from monies raised by levy, debentures and government subsidy for expenditure on construction and maintenance of the roads of streets in said town-village during the year 1951 as follows:

- (2) The said monies shall be expended on work performed in accordance with the Highway Improvement Act.
- (3) The clerk shall transmit duplicate copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, not later than the 28th day of February of this year.
