

BY-LAW NO 943

A by-law for fixing a time and place for holding a nomination meeting and for polling and for providing for certain municipal officers.

Whereas it is expedient to provide by by-law for the fixing of a time and place for holding an election meeting for the receiving of nominations for Reeve and Councilors and School Trustees and for polling for and for appointing certain municipal officers.

Therefore the municipal Council of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows.

That the meeting for receiving of nominations for Reeve and Councilors and School Trustees shall be held in the Memorial hall on 23rd. day of November 1953 from the hour of Seven thirtyp.m. to the hour of Eight Thirty p.m.

That in case a poll be demanded such poll shall be held in the Memorial hall on the 30th. day of November 1953 from the hour of Eleven O'Clock a.m. to the hour of Seven O'clockp.m.

That the following persons are hereby appointed to act as municipal officers-


D.R.O.....J.A.Sammon

That the clerk is hereby instructed to give and publish the necessary notices and to hold the meeting as aforesaid at the time and places mentioned and in such manner as directed by the statutes of Ontario.
