VILLAGE OF COBDEN

By-Law No. / 0 33

A by-law to construct water mains on Cowley and Pembroke Streets

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden deem it desirable and in the public interest to construct certain watermains on Cowley and Pembroke Streets in the said Village as more particularly hereinafter specified, at an estimated cost of \$16.600

AND WHEREAS Certificate No.58-B-370 of the Ontario Water Resources Commission has been granted to authorize said work.

AND WHEREAS the Ontario Municipal Board by Order No. E3-12 dated the 28 day of Cataber 1958 has authorized and approved the said work.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

- 1. That the water works system of the said Village be extended by constructing 6-inch water mains on Cowley Street from its intersection with Gould Street to its intersection with Pembroke Street, a distance of 480 feet, and on Pembroke Street from its intersection with Cowley Street to a point distant 265 feet south from the Village limits, a distance of 2,070 feet, at a total estimated cost of \$ 16.600
- 2. That the said work be executed under the superintendence of and in accordance with the plan and report covering same prepared by J. F. Richards & Associates, Consulting Engineer.

- 3. The Reeve and Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to cause a contract or contracts for the construction of the said work to be made and entered into with some person or persons, firm or corporation, subject to the approval of this Council.
- 4. The Clerk-Treasurer may, subject to the approval of this Council, agree with any bank, person or persons for the temporary advances of money to meet the cost of the said work or any part or parts thereof pending the completion thereof.

5. That the said work be financed by the issue of debentures repayable by the Corporation at large over a period of 15 years.
