

THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO. 1127

A by-law to licence trailers.

AND WHEREAS local municipalities are empowered to pass by-laws under the provisions of the Municipal Act, R.S.O., 1960, Ch. 249, Sec. 379(85) to licence trailers.

THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

1. The word "trailer" herein shall mean and include any vehicle so constructed that it is suitable for being attached to a motor vehicle for the purpose of being drawn or propelled by the motor vehicle, and capable of being used for the living, sleeping or eating accommodation of persons, notwithstanding that such vehicle is jacked up or that its running gear is removed.
2. Every person in possession of a trailer located in the Municipality of the Village of Cobden for a period exceeding thirty days in any calendar year shall be liable to pay and shall pay to the Treasurer of the Municipality a licence fee of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each month or portion thereof in excess of the said thirty day period, and the said monthly payments shall be paid in advance on or before the first day of each and every month.
3. This by-law shall not apply to any trailer located in the Municipality only for the purpose of sale or storage.
4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law shall be liable to a penalty of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and not more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each offence, exclusive of costs.
