BY-LAW No. 1151

A By-Law for fixing the time and place for holding a Nomination Meeting and for Polling, if nacessary, and providing for certion Municipal Officers.

Whereas it is expedient to provide, by by-law, for the fixing of a time and place for holding an nomination meeting to receive nominations for the office of Reeve, Councillors, Public School Trustrees and Separate School Trusrees for the Village of Cobden, and for Polling, if necessary, and for providing for cetion Municipal Officers.

^Therefor the Municipal Council of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:-

That the meeting for receiving nominations for:

Reeve, Four Councillors, Three Public School Trustrees and Three Separate School Trustrees shall be held in the Cobden Community Memorial Centre on Monday, November 27th, 1961 from 7.30 to 8.30 P.M.

And in the case of a Foll being demanded such Poll shall be held at the same place Monday December 4th,1961 from llA.M. to 7 P.M.
