BY-LAW No. 1177

A By-Law for fixing the time and place for holding a Nomination Meeting in the Village of Cobden and for polling, if necessary, and providing for certain Municipal Officers.

And in the case of a poll being demanded such poll will be held at the same place Monday December 3, 1962, from 11.04.M., tof7 P.M.
