Dear Sir: Re: Supplementary Road Expenditure By-Law No. 1217 Amount - \$ 36,000.00

Please be advised that the above cited by-law has received consideration as a charge against the allotment for Special Capital Projects in the Department's estimates for the current fiscal year.

The Honourable C. S. MacNaughton, Minister of Highways, has approved of the proposed expenditure for subsidy purposes, to a limit of

\$ 36,000.00

for Construction,

SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

- 1.
- That the expenditure(s) shall be made only for the purposes set out in the by-law and supporting programme and shall not be diverted, either in whole or in part, to any other purpose, without the prior consent in writing of the Municipal Engineer.
- 2. That the individual works of road construction and bridge construction shall be subject to the approval of an engineer of the Municipal Roads Division.
- 3. That tenders for work to be undertaken by contract shall be publicly advertised and Department subsidy shall apply on the amount of the lowest tender only unless the Municipal Engineer approves subsidy on a higher tender.
- N. B. In the event that any portion of the cost of the proposed work or purchase is to be raised in a subsequent year or financed by the issue of debentures, the approval of the Ontario Municipal Board must be obtained before the work or purchase is authorized or any commitment made with respect thereto.

A copy of the by-law as approved is returned herewith.

SUPPLEMENTARY

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 19.64 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS OR STREETS

IN THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN. IN THE COUNTY OF RENFREW

WHEREAS under The Highway Improvement Act a by-law to provide for expenditures on roads or streets may be submitted annually to the Minister of Highways for approval.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said XXXXXXVillage enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$...36,000.00..... is hereby estimated as the expenditure upon the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 19.64 as follows:

(2) The said monies shall be expended on work performed in accordance with The Highway Improvement Act.

(3) The clerk shall transmit **duplicate** copies of this by-law to the district office of the Municipal Roads Branch, Department of Highways, not later than March 31st, of the said year.

(4) The approval of the Ontario Municipal Board shall be obtained before any expenditure is authorized or work commenced which will be financed by the issue of debentures or monies raised in a subsequent year.



THE BOARD ORDERS, under and in pursuance of the legislation





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hereinbefore referred to, and of any and all other powers vested in the Board, that the said application be and the same is hereby granted, and that the Corporation may now proceed with the said project, and may pass all requisite by-laws, including by-laws providing for the issue of debentures repayable over a term 6 not more than fifteen years, and may borrow money to the extent sufficient to provide an amount not exceeding \$18,000.00 for the said purpose, provided, however, that the amount to be debentured shall not exceed in any event the net cost to the Corporation after deducting any grant or contribution from the Province of Ontario or from any other source in respect of the said work.

AND THE BOARD DECLARES AND DIRECTS that the assent of the electors of the Village of Cobden or those qualified to vote on money by-laws shall not be requisite to be obtained to the exercise by the Corporation of the powers aforesaid.
