



BY-LAW NO. 1248

A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE 1965 EXPENDITURES ON ROADS OR STREETS

IN THE TOWN OF Cobden IN THE COUNTY OF Renfrew  
IN THE VILLAGE OF Cobden IN THE DISTRICT OF Renfrew

WHEREAS under <sup>SEC. 84</sup> The Highway Improvement Act a by-law to provide for expenditures on roads or streets may be submitted annually to the Minister of Highways for approval. <sup>STORM SEWERS</sup>

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the said Town/Village enacts as follows:

(1) The sum of \$ 12,296.00 is hereby estimated as the expenditure upon the construction and maintenance of the roads and bridges under its jurisdiction during the year 1965 as follows: <sup>STORM DRAINS</sup>

SEC. 84
