

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO. 1250

A By-Law to authorize a Project in Observance and Commemoration of the Centennial.

Whereas the Confederation Centennial Act 1962-63 provides that Municipal Councils may make expenditures for or grants toward the observance or the commemoration of the Centennial.

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to observe and commemorate the Centennial by the construction of a Viewing Stand, Club Rooms and Dressing Rooms at the Cobden Community Sports Centre.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Villige of Cobden ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1. That in observance and commemoration of the Centennial the Corporation shall construct a Viewing Stand, Club Rooms and Dressing Rooms at the Cobden Community Sports Centre. The proposed building will have Cement Block Walls, Concrete Floors and Steel Roof with necessary Partitions and Toilet Facilities, it will have a floor space of approximately 1800 sq. ft., the estimated cost of the project is Ninety-five Hundred Dollars ( \$ 9,500.00 )
2. That the Reeve and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized and directed to make application pursuant to the regulations made under the Confederation Centennial Act 1962-63 for a grant in aid of the project.
