

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO. 1291

A By-Law for the submission to a vote of questions under The Liquor Licence Act.

WHEREAS at the time of the coming into force of the Ontario Temperance Act, a by-law No. 148 passed under The Liquor Licence Act was in force within the limits of the municipality prohibiting the sale of Liquor by retail therein.

AND WHEREAS under Section 72 (1) of the Liquor Licence Act, the Council of a municipality in which the by-law was in force may submit to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the Voters' list and to vote at Elections to the Assembly in the Municipality any question or questions set forth under The Liquor Licence Act.

AND WHEREAS the Council deems it expedient and desirable to submit to a vote of the persons qualified to vote thereon as aforesaid the following questions:-

Are you in favour of the establishment of Government stores for the sale of liquor?

Are you in favour of the establishment of Government stores for the sale of beer only for residence consumption?

AND WHEREAS the Council having requested the Board to fix a day for taking the vote on the questions, the Board has fixed Wednesday the 23rd day of November, A.D., 1966.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary to provide by by-law for the submission of the said questions to the persons qualified to vote thereon and for the taking of their votes thereon.

THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:-

1. Under The Liquor Licence Act, there is hereby submitted to a vote of the persons qualified to be entered on the Voters' list and to vote at Elections to the Assembly in the municipality the following questions:-

Are you in favour of the establishment of Government stores for the sale of liquor?

Are you in favour of the establishment of Government stores for the sale of beer only for residence consumption?

2. The vote shall be taken on Wednesday the 23rd day of November, A.D., 1966, as directed by The Liquor Licence Board of Ontario and in accordance with The Liquor Licence Act.

FINALLY PASSED THIS 8th day of September A.D., 1966.
