

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NUMBER 1406

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OWNERS OF DOGS ALLOWING THE DISTURBANCE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

WHEREAS Section 379 (1) 114 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1960 as amended, provides the authority for regulating noises likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Cobden.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prohibit the disturbance of residents of the Village of Cobden

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

- 1. That no person shall allow a dog or dogs of which he is the owner or which he harbours to bark or make noise in such a manner as to disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Cobden.
- 2. That any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law shall upon conviction, incur a penalty of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars or more than One Hundred Dollars exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Ontario Summary Conviction Act.
