## VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO.7/-24

A By-law to construct an extension of a water main pipe line on Main Street.

WHEREAS The Public Utilities Act, R.S.O. 1960, Ch. 335, Part 1, authorizes a local municipality to operate a waterworks system and for the purpose of distributing the water, may, among other things lay down pipes.

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden in connection with the operation of its waterworks system, deems it to be necessary and desirable to extend the water distribution system on Main Street by extending the existing main westerly thereon.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted and it is hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Cobden, as follows:

- 1. That the existing six-inch water pipe on Main Street which now ends at a hydrant at a point distant 525 feet east of Ross Street be extended westerly along Main Street by the construction and laying down of an eight-inch ductile water pipe from its connection with the said existing pipe to a point on Main Street distant 900 feet west of Ross Street, for an over all length of 1460 feet.
- 2. That a six-inch water service pipe be installed and laid down from the westerly end of the said eight-inch main pipe line to the interior wall of a factory building to be owned and constructed by Quexoil Limited, a distance of 50 feet, minimum, but not to exceed 200 feet
- 3. That as part of the said work, two hydrants and all necessary valves, fittings, couplings and accessories be installed.
- 4. That the said work be carried out under the supervision of the Village and according to the plans and specifications prepared by J. L. Richards and Associates dated June, 1971.
- 5. That the estimated cost of the whole work, including supervision, consulting and legal fees and miscellaneous expense is \$35,000.00.
- 6. That the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enter into an Agreement with Quexoil Limited and/or its representatives toprovide

for the installation of said main pipe line and the said service pipe line and to provide for a payment by Quexoil Limited to the Corporation of the Village of Cobden of an amount equal to half the said estimated cost up to a maximum of \$17,500.00.

- 7. That application be made immediately to the Ontario Municipal Board for approval of the said work and expenditure.
- 8. That application be made to the Ontario Municipal Board for permission to issue debentures for that part of the cost thereof to be financed by the Village of Cobden, estimated at \$17,500, repayable over a period of 100 years, bearing interest at a rate not exceeding 100 % per annum.
