

VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW NO. 71-30

A By-Law to regulate and prohibit the sale of fireworks and to prohibit and regulate the setting off of fireworks.

AND WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1970, Ch. 284, Secs. 354(31) and (32) empowers a local municipality to regulate and prohibit the sale of fireworks and to regulate and prohibit fireworks displays.


THEREFORE BE IT ENACTED:

And it is hereby enacted by the Municipal Council of the Village of Cobden, as follows:

1. No person shall at any time sell within the Village of Cobden any class or classes of fireworks to any person.
2. No person shall at any time set off fireworks or hold fireworks displays unless and until he shall have received a permit authorizing same.
3. All by-laws or parts of by-laws inconsistent herewith are hereby revoked.
4. Every person who contravenes the provisions of this By-Law shall be liable to a fine of not more than \$300, exclusive of costs, recoverable under the Summary Convictions Act.
