

VILLAGE OF COBDEN

By-Law No. 75-5

A by-law to control the operation
of Snowmobiles

WHEREAS Sec. 6 (2) of the Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, R.S.O. 1970, ch. 283, empowers a local municipality to pass bylaws to regulate and govern the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality including any highway therein or any part or parts thereof.

THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. For the purpose of this by-law the word "street" shall include the roadway and sidewalk or any public walkway or thoroughfare, or such part or parts thereof as is under the jurisdiction of the said Village.
2. No person shall operate a motorized snow vehicle on any street of the said Village except only for the purpose of moving such vehicle to or from the place where such vehicle is usually stored and the outer perimeter of the Village.
3. This by-law shall take effect on the final passing thereof.
