BY-LAW NO. 76-13

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPOINT-MENT OF A MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER WHEREAS Subsection 63 of Section 352 of The Municipal Act authorizes a Council of a Municipality to enact a by-law appointing such officers as may be necessary for the purposes of the Corporation for carrying into effect the provisions of any Act of the legislature or by-law of the Municipality and for fixing the remuneration of such officers and the prescribing of their duties.

AND WHEREAS Section 68 of the Police Act, R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284 authorizes the Council of a Municipality to appoint Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden deems it advisable to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the Municipality.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1) THAT Martin Teeple be and he is hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden for the purpose of enforcing the by-laws of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden.

2) THAT the remuneration to be paid to the said Municipal Law Enforcement Officer is to be that as may be determined from time to time by by-law passed by the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden.

3) THAT the duties of the said Municipal Law Enforcement Officer shall be to carry into effect the provisions of any and all by-laws of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden, to investigate infringements and offences of the provisions of the said by-laws and to lay charges in connection therewith in the proper Court and to see to the presecution thereof and 'such further and other duties as may from time to time be assigned to him, either by by-law or by resolution of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden.

4) This by-law shall come into effect on the final passing thereof. READ A FIRST, SECOND AND THIRD TIME THIS THIRD DAY OF AUGUST, 1976
