BYLAW 78-8

Being a bylaw to authorize the carrying on of a community program of recreation.

The council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden

ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. A Community Programme of Recreation is hereby established for the residents of the Municipality of the Village of Cobden.
 - (a) Pursuant to the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 284, Part XIX, Section 352, sub-section 32, 68-71 and 74 and regulations made thereunder.
 - (b) Pursuant to the Ministry of Culture and Recreation Act, and regulations made thereunder.
2. THAT the said "Community Programme of Recreation" shall be directed and managed on behalf of the Council of the Municipality by a committee to be known as the "Cobden Athletic and Recreation Association" and referred to hereinafter in this bylaw as the "Committee".
3. THE said Committee shall conduct and/or encourage and assist the programme of recreation which will meet the needs and interests of the inhabitants of the Municipality. Such programmes shall include social, cultural, educational and physical aspects of recreation as applied to each age group, both male and female.
4. POWERS and DUTIES of said COMMITTEE:
 - (a) The committee shall provide such services as will encourage and assist the development of optimum recreational opportunities to meet the needs and interests of the inhabitants of the Municipality.
 - (b) The committee shall encourage co-operation and co-ordination in the Community's recreation activities and services.
 - (c) The committee shall provide advice and information as required to all groups, organizations and institutions carrying on recreation activities in the Municipality.
 - (d) The committee shall at all times keep the inhabitants of the Municipality aware of the recreational opportunities which are available and will continually interpret to the public the total community programme of recreation.
 - (e) The Committee shall be responsible for all policies, rules and regulations relating to the administration of the programme conducted by the committee.
 - (f) The Committee may appoint committees and authorize such committees to operate in geographical or special interest areas, and to provide such services as it deems necessary to assist these committees in carrying on their activities.
 - (g) The Committee may recommend to the Municipal Council, the appointment of a properly trained and qualified Municipal Recreation Director and such other continuing staff as may be required.
 - (h) The Committee may appoint part-time recreation workers on a paid or voluntary basis and shall be responsible for assigning the duties and

responsibilities of such persons.

- (i) The Committee is authorized to work jointly with other municipal services in establishing, operating and maintaining a supervised public recreation system of facilities and activities.
- (j) The Committee may solicit or receive gifts or requests of money and services to be applied in furtherance of the Municipal programme of recreation.
- (k) The Committee shall hold regular monthly meetings, and a quorum shall be a majority of those members appointed. Nothing in the foregoing shall be deemed to prohibit the holding of such additional meetings as may be deemed necessary by the Committee.

5. COMPOSITION of the said COMMITTEE:

- (a) The said Committee shall be composed of eight members, of whom two shall be members of the Municipal Council.

Members: Lynne Dunn, James Dunn, Harvey Moss, Teresa Moore, Robert Childerhass, R. K. Schilling - Council Members: G. H. Duncan and Walter Schroeder.

- (b) The said Committee shall be appointed ANNUALLY by the Municipal Council.

- 6. ALL RESOLUTIONS, RULES AND REGULATIONS OF the said Committee shall be subject to the approval of the Municipal Council.
- 7. The Committee shall establish a BANK ACCOUNT to be known as the Village of Cobden Athletic & Recreation Association bank account.
- 8. THE SIGNING OFFICERS OF the said Bank Account shall be the Treasurer of the said Committee, and the Treasurer of the Municipality.
- 9. The BOOKS and ACCOUNTS of the said Committee shall be submitted, on demand to the Municipal Treasurer for AUDIT at such times as the books and accounts of the Municipality are being audited.
- 10. On or before the FIRST day of February of each year, the Committee shall submit to the Municipal Council a detailed estimate of its budget requirements for the then current year.
- 11. The Committee shall submit to the Municipality an annual report of its activities, and such other reports as may be required.
- 12. In carrying out the provisions of this bylaw, the Committee shall be at all times, the agent of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden and while acting bona fide within the limits of the authority of this bylaw, neither the Committee nor any member therefor shall incur any liability by reason of anything done or left undone by the Committee, PROVIDED, however that nothing in this paragraph contained shall authorize or empower the Committee to incur any debt, liability or obligation for which the Municipality of the Village of Cobden shall become liable without having previously obtained the consent of the Council.
