## BY-LAW NO. 78-17

A By-law to establish a Community Recreation Centre at Cobden.

Whereas the Community Recreation Centres Act, 1974, provides in Section 2(1) that the Council of any municipality may, by by-law provide for the establishment of one or more community recreation centres in accordance with the said Act and may acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise real and personal property for that purpose;

And whereas the Corporation of the Village of Cobden is desirous of establishing a community recreation centre at Cobden in the County of Renfrew.

Therefore, the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

- 1. That a community recreation centre defined as (a community hall, and skating arena be established and operated by the Corporation pursuant to the provisions of the Community Recreation Centres Act, 1974.
- 2. That the said community recreation centre be administered by a committee of management appointed pursuant to the provision of the Community Recreation Centres Act and Regulations thereunder, which committee shall be composed as follows:
  - Lynne Dunn, Harvey Moss, Theresa Moore, Robert Childerhose, Gordon Duncan, Jim Dunn, Walter Schroeder.
- That the Reeve and the Clerk be and they are hereby authorized to execute all documents necessary to give effect to the foregoing.
