BY-LAW # 1988-15

BEING a by-law to amend by-law # 1987-25 Article III Holidays

WHEREAS By-Law # 1987-25 Article III (b) States that: "permanent Employees after one year will receive three weeks vacation with pay, after ten years will receive four weeks vacation, and after twenty years will receive five weeks vacation with pay."

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden feels that a maximum number of consecutive holiday days should be enforced to ensure that the duties of the village are being conducted in an effective and efficient manner,

THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows;

- (I) THAT ~~Article III~~ of By-laws 1987-25 be amended to include subsection (d) No one person shall take more than two weeks holidays without obtaining Council approval in advance
- (II) THAT all holiday requests be submitted to the General office by April 1 of the year in question for review by Council.
- (III) THAT this by-law shall come into effect on the day which it is passed.

READ a first, second, and passed on the third reading this 28th day of December 19th 88.
