Being a By-Law to regulate smoking in the Astrolabe Arena.

<u>WHEREAS</u> Section 193 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980@Chapter 302, authorizes Councils of Municipalities to pass by-laws for acquiring, protecting and regulating the use of lands and building\$required for the purposes of the Corporation, and

<u>WHEREAS</u> Section 104 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1980 Chapter 302, authorizes Council of Municipalities to pass by-lawsand regulations as may be deemed to be expedient for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the Municipality, and

<u>WHEREAS</u> Council deems it to be expedient and in the public interest to regulate smoking in certain public buildings owned and operated for the purposes of the Corporation.

<u>NOW THEREFORE</u> the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

- 1. THAT in this By=Law:
 - a) <u>"Arena</u>" means an enclosed artificial ice surface and its ancillary facilities;
 - b) <u>"Lobby"</u> means any hall, isle, passageway, or area intended and used for the circulation of persons or goods and may include a "waiting room".
 - c) <u>"Smoke"</u> or<u>"Smoking"</u> means the use or exposed carrying of a lighted cigar, cigarette, pipe, or any other smoking equipment.
- 2. THAT no person shall smoke in the Lobby of the Cobden Astrolabe Aßena.
- 3. THAT the Arena Manager shall post or cause to be posted up, notices in the form specified in Appendix "A" to this By-Law in the Lobby of the Astrolabe Arena.
- 4. Any person who contravenes any section of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), excluding costs, recoverable under the Provincial Offenses Act.

5. THAT this By-Law shall come into full force and effect immediately.
