CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW # 1992-23

Being a by-Daw to establish Water and Sewer rates for the Village of Cobden.

WHEREAS, The Municipal Act, Chapter 302 of the Revised Statutes of the Province of Ontario, 1980, Section 218, subsection (10) authorizes Council to pass a by-law imposing sewer or water works rates.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-Law 1992-6 and the amendments are thereto herby rescended.
- 2. That the water and sewer rates shall be due in four installments due on the following dates:
 - a) Last working day of January
 - b) Last working day of May
 - c) Last working day of July
 - d) Last working day of October
- 3. That the Treasurer is hereby authorized to mail or cause to be mailed the notices of the rates due to the address of the owner of the land assessed.
- 4. That water and sewer billing can be paid either at the Municipal Office or at The Bank of Nova Scotia, Cobden branch, until due date. All past-due amounts shall be paid at the Municipal Office.
- 5. That a penalty at the rate of 5% on each past-due account shall be assessed on the first day of default after the due date indicated on the notice.
- 6. That the water and sewer rates shall be increased as follows:
 - a) For all General Service/monthly water charge and increase of \$3.00 month
 - b) For every \$16.00/monthly water charge an increase of \$3.00/month.
 - c) For all General Service/monthly sewage charge an increase of \$3.00/month.
 - d) For every \$16.00/monthly sewage charge an increase of \$3.00/month.

e) All increases are to be pro-rated for each multiple of \$16.00 month charged per account

- i.e. existing Water & Sewer Charge = 32.00/monthincrease (3.00×2) = 6.00/monthNew Rate = 38.00/month
- f) Metered water rates \$2.76/1000 ga.

7. That these increases shall be in effect as of January 1, 1993.
