

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW # 1993-11

BEING a by-law to require the owners of a dog to remove the waste within the municipality.

WHEREAS under the provision of the Municipal Act Chapter M.45 Section 210(9) RSO 1990 the Council may pass by-laws to require the owners of a dog to remove forthwith the excrement left by the dog anywhere in the Municipality.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden institute and enforce the restrictions under this authority.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Village of Cobden ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the owner of a dog shall be required forthwith to remove excrement left by the dog in the municipality.
2. THAT the provisions of this by-law shall be enforced by any person appointed by the Council.
3. THAT any person found guilty of contravening this by-law shall be liable to a fine of TWENTY-EIGHT DOLLARS AND FIFTY CENTS (\$28.50) exclusive of costs and every such fine is recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
