BY-LAW # 1994-12

A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE OWNERS OF DOGS ALLOWING  
THE DISTURBANCE OF THE INHABITANTS OF THE VILLAGE  
OF COBDEN


WHEREAS Section 302 (132) of the Municipal Act RSO 1990 as amended provides the authority for regulating noises likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Cobden.

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to prevent the disturbance of residents of the Village of Cobden.


NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Cobden enacts as follows:

1. That no person shall allow a dog of which he is the owner or which he harbours to bark or make noise in such a manner as to disturb the inhabitants of the Village of Cobden.
2. That any person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law shall upon conviction, incur a penalty of not less than twenty-eight dollars or more than One hundred and fifty dollars, exclusive of costs, and all such penalties shall be recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.

READ a first, second and passed on the third reading this *11<sup>th</sup>* day of *October* 1994.
