

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW # 1995-12

Being a By-law to regulate smoking in the Municipal Offices and Council Chambers.


WHEREAS Section 213 Subsection 2 of the Municipal Act R.S.O. 1990 Chapter 302 authorizes Council of Municipalities to pass by-laws and regulations as may be deemed to be expedient for the health, safety, morality and welfare of the inhabitants of the Municipality.

WHEREAS Council deems it to be expedient and in the public interest to regulate smoking in certain public buildings owned and operated for the purposes of the Corporation.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden enact as follows:

1. That no person shall smoke in the Municipal Offices including Council Chambers.
2. That one area be designated as a smoking area it must be equipped with a ventilation system to the outside of the building. The designated smoking room be the staff room.
3. Any person who contravenes any section of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.00), excluding costs, recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
4. That this by-law shall come into full force and effect immediately.
