

CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

BY-LAW # 1997-9

A BY-LAW RELATING TO THE USE, REGULATION, PROTECTION AND GOVERNMENT OF PARKS IN THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden has the whole management and control of the public parks in the Village of Cobden under the Public Parks Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council Of The Corporation of the Village of Cobden desires to enact a bylaw to govern the conduct of all persons who, in any way, use the parks operated under The Corporation of the Village of Cobden;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS

- (1) "PARK" means and includes all public parks, public beaches and recreation grounds in the Village of Cobden under the control of the Village of Cobden.
- (2) "VEHICLE" shall include any off road motor cycle, snowmobile, any type of water vessel, farm or lawn tractor, all terrain vehicle, golf cart and any type of vehicle drawn, propelled or driven by any kind of power, including muscle power, but shall not include wheelchairs.

SECTION 2 - USE OF PARK AREAS

No person shall:

1) operate or park a vehicle on any area without the consent of the Corporation; this provision not to include emergency vehicles, maintenance equipment owned by the Village or vehicles or equipment authorized to be there by the Village.


SECTION 3 - PENALTY


Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and, on conviction, is liable to a fine, under The Provincial Offences Act, of \$50.00, exclusive of costs, or to imprisonment for a term of not more than six months, or to both, and is liable to an action at the suit of the Corporation to make good any damages caused by him. This by-law may be enforced and the penalties thereunder recovered in a like manner as by-laws of municipal councils and the penalties thereunder may be enforced and recovered and recovered, and every fine so imposed shall belong to the Corporation.

SECTION 4

This by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.
