# THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF COBDEN 

## BYLAW \#1999-6

Being a bylaw to regulate the use of Portable Signs on public property.
WHEREAS The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 210, provides that the Council of a Municipality may pass bylaws for prohibiting or regulating the erection of Portable Signs;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of there Village of Cobden deems it advisable to pass such a Bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Village of Cobden hereby enacts as follows:

## SECTION 1 - DEFINITION

"Portable Sign" means any sign which is specifically designed or intended to be readily moved from one location to another, and which does not rely on a building or fixed foundation for its structural support and shall include all signs commonly known as "A-Boards".
"Sidewalk" means the 5 ' foot concrete right a way located along the sides of the road allowance.

## SECTION 2 - PORTABLE SIGNS

a) "A-Board " sign shall not be permitted on the sidewalks or permitted to encroach the sidewalk.
b) "A-Board" signs shall only be permitted on bricked boulevards located on the street side of the sidewalks in the last quarter of the boulevards beginning at the intersection. The A-Board sign must be adjacent to the sidewalk. Also the A-Board sign must be a maximum size of $40 " \mathrm{H} \times 48^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{W}$.
c) "A-Board " signs shall be removed at the close of business hours and shall be removed by owners during snow removal operations .
d) The Village of Cobden will not be liable for any damage incurred to any "A-Board "signs

## SECTION 3 - PENALTY

Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence, and on summary conviction under The Provincial Offences Act is liable to a fine not to exceed $\$ 500.00$ for each day he is in contravention of such Order.

SECTION - This bylaw shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof.
