

Ross May 18<sup>th</sup> 1867

Pursuant to adjournment of date March 2<sup>d</sup> the Municipal Corporation of Ross met in the Town Hall on Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup> day of May at 10 o'clock for noon as a court of Revision the Reeve and all the Councillors present the minutes of preceding meeting were read and confirmed.

There being no complaints before the Revision the following Motions and resolutions were moved seconded and carried

Moved by Mr Hill seconded by Mr Campbell that the Clerk be authorized to certify the assessment Roll there being no complaints before the Revision

Motion 2

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that this Council resolve itself into a committee of the whole for the purpose of appropriating the money that is in the Bressage.

Motion 3<sup>d</sup>

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill and resolved that the sums mentioned in the memorandum attached to this resolution be expended on the different kinds of roads mentioned therein within the Burroughs and that the Reeve be and he is hereby empowered and authorized to engage a fit and proper person with the advice of at least two of the Councillors to expend and to superintend the laying out of said monies, the salary of the party so engaged not to exceed two dollars per day, for every day actually engaged in expending the monies and superintending the work, the party so engaged to make a true report to the Council at its next sitting, what he may have done in the premises, the monies to be expended during the summer season of 1867

Moved by Mr Spencer seconded by Mr Campbell that John Marshall receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of one Dollar the Compensation for three Sheep killed by Dog or Dogs and that Michael Goussard receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of six Dollars for two Sheep killed by Dog or Dogs out of the funds set apart for that purpose
