

Ross October 2^d 1869

Pursuant to adjournment of date August 3^d the Municipal Corporation of Ross met in the Town Hall on Wednesday the second day of October at 10 O'clock A.M. the Reeve and all the Councillors present the Minutes of preceding Meeting were read and confirmed

Motion 1st

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that the By Law fixing the rate of taxes at one cent four Mills on the Dollar on all the real and personal property in the Township be brought up and read a first time

Carried

Motion 2^d

Moved by Mr Campbell seconded by Mr Squires that By Law N^o 123 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed

Carried

Motion 3^d

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that Henry Childen have receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of eleven Dollars twenty five cents the Value of four sheep killed by Dog or Dogs to be paid out of the funds set apart for that purpose

Motion 4th

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that By Law N^o 124 for the payment of certain sums of Money for work done on roads and Bridges be brought up and read a first time

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that the sum of ten Dollars be granted to improve the Town line between Horton and Ross

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that J. W. Squires Esq be and he is hereby instructed to lay out by contract the sum of ten Dollars in repairing the Town line between Horton and Ross along lot N^o 27 and that he grant a Certificate to the party doing the work on which the amount will be paid by the Treasurer

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that Francis Levan received certification to obtain a License to keep a house of Public entertainment from the first day of October to the first day of March 1868

Moved by Mr Marshall Seconded by Mr Hill that By Law No 124 for the payment of certain sums of Money, be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed

Moved by Mr Campbell that Seconded by Mr Hill that the ten Dollars received from Francis Levan for license be handed over to the Treasurer

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that a By Law be passed at this sitting of Council authorizing Robert Allen to copy from the Collectors Roll on the seventeenth day of December next all those who have paid their taxes up to that date and that the Collector pay over all the Money he may have collected as taxes to the Treasurer at the same time and that Rule 25 of Bylaws No 69 be suspended for that purpose

Moved by Mr Marshall seconded by Mr Hill that By Law No 125 for the copying of a Voters List from the Collectors Roll to be used at the Election for Officers and Councillors for 1868 be brought up and read a first time

Moved by Mr Marshall Seconded by Mr Hill that By Law No 124 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed

Motion 13

Moved by M^r Marshall seconded by M^r Hill that this Council proceed to Survey the blank Concession line between pumping line N^o 15 16 and pumping line 20 & 21 and that the same be empowered to engage William Bell Esq^r Surveyor to run said line

Moved by M^r Marshall seconded by M^r Hill that George Marshall receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of three Dollars for work done on the crossway round the Head of Muskate Lake

Moved by M^r Marshall seconded by M^r Squires that the Clerk be and he is hereby authorized to notify the Trustees of School Sections A and three that application has been made to this Council to alter the boundaries of said sections and that a special meeting of Council will be called for the purpose of deciding on the Question and Notice will be given in due time by the Clerk

Moved by M^r Marshall seconded by M^r Hill that this Council do now adjourn to meet on the thirty first day of December in the Town Hall at 10 O'clock for a year
