Pursuant to adjournment of date Oct^r 2^d the Municipal Corporation of the Township of Pass met in the Town Hall on Tuesday the thirty first day of Dec^r at 10 O'clock for noon the Police and all the Councillors present the Minutes of preceding meeting were read and confirmed
