S. for the purpose of ascertaining if there was left an allowance of road on the blank Concession lines in the Original Survey of this Township and that the Treasurer furnish the necessary expenses

Moved by M^r Reilly seconded by M^r Marshall that this Council agree to give J^r A. Walker Publisher of the Pembroke Chronicle the sum of fifteen Dollars a year for publishing Minutes of Council Court of Assessment and Auditors report

Moved by M^r Marshall seconded by M^r Hill that John Rankin J^r and Gustav Huntington receive a Certificate to obtain a License to keep a house of Public Entertainment from the first of March 1868 till the first of March 1869 and that John Crawford receive a Shop License for the same period

Moved by W^m Hill seconded by W^m Reilly that William Harwick receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of thirty five Dollars the same being remaining part of salary for assessing and collecting in 1867

Moved by W^m Wallace seconded by W^m Reilly that this Council adjourn to meet on the first Saturday of April as a Court of Sessions and to transact any other business that may come before them
