Pursuant to adjournment of date of 25<sup>th</sup> the Municipal Corporation of Cross met in the Town Hall on Saturday the first day of August at 10 o'clock forenoon present all the Councillors and Reeve John Marshall Esq<sup>r</sup> Chairman the minutes of preceding meeting were read and confirmed

Moved by M<sup>r</sup> Wallace seconded by M<sup>r</sup> Reilly that the auditors receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of three Dollars each for auditing the Township accounts

Moved by M<sup>r</sup> Reilly seconded by M<sup>r</sup> Wallace that the Clerk of Council receive an Order on the Treasurer for the sum of thirty Dollars paid payment of salary,

Moved by Mr. Smith seconded by Mr. Hill that By Law 1864 be brought up and read a first time empowering the Treasurer to borrow three Hundred Dollars for the use of the Corporation  
Carried

Motion 8

Moved by Mr. Smith seconded by Mr. Hill that By Law 1864 be brought up and read a second and third time short and passed

Moved by Mr. Hill seconded by Mr. Wallace that this Council do adjourn to meet on the first Saturday of Oct<sup>r</sup> next in the Danvers Hall at 10 o'clock forenoon
