The Petition of Robt Johnston & nine others praying
for a grant of money to repair the road in
front of lots number 1 & 2 & half of 3 in the 7th Con,

One from Guy Merwin for money (\$400) claimed
by him for work done on the road of which he
is Parhamaster

Petition from John Greff & others praying to have
the Union School section at 3 in Rps & 7 in Norton
broken up and attaching that part of it known
as No 3 in Rps joined to school section No 2
Rps thereby making one good section in the Township
of Rps

the afo'sd petitions be laid over for consideration at
the next meeting of this Council - being on the 8th
day of May Next

read the first time
