

Minutes of Ross Council March 5th 1870

The Reeve and all the Councillors present
Dawson Elliott took and subscribed the declarations
of qualification and office

The Reeve in the chair

Minutes of former meeting read, and signed
by the Reeve.

Mr. Hill gave notice that that
he will at the present meeting of Council
introduce a bylaw for the purpose of
fixing the amount of Tavern and Shop
licences for the Township of Ross for the year
1870

Moved by William Wilson seconded by
Mr. Ross that William Coleman and James
Marshall receive an order on Treasurer
for the sum of \$2⁰⁰ each for services
as auditors for 1869 - Carried

Moved by William Ross & seconded by
Dawson Elliott that an order be drawn
on Treasurer in favour of John Marshall
Reeve for expenses attending Township
business in Pembroke - Carried

Moved by William Wilson seconded by
John Hill that Crastus Huntington and
Thomas Hill Sen. receive certificates each
to obtain license to keep a tavern in the
Township of Ross - Carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott & seconded by
William Wilson that Edward Suttiff receive
an order on the Treasurer for
\$2⁰⁰ being for extra labour done on the 5th
line of Ross - Carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott & seconded
by William Wilson that the sum of
twelve dollars be granted to repair
the hill between No 10 & 11 on the 3^d con,
(Carried)

Moved by William Wilson & seconded by
Mr. Ross that the sum of twelve dollars
be granted for the repairing of the 7th
concession — Carried.

Moved by Mr. Ross seconded by John
Hisco that Robert C Allen's Statute labor
be forgiven to him as he is old & infirm.
Am't, \$4⁰⁰ ... (Carried)

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by Mr. Wilson
that the sum of \$50⁰⁰ be granted to build a
bridge at Mr. Byers Carding mill and that Mr. Byers
be and he is hereby appointed to expend the same
(Carried)

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by Mr. Ross
that John Reynolds, Collector receive an order
on Treasurer for \$35 for services as
assessor & collector for the year 1869. Carried.

Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded
by William Wilson that Bylaw No 138 for
fixing Tavern & Shop licenses be brought
up & read a first time (Carried)
It was read a first time accordingly

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by Mr. Wilson that
Bylaw No 138 be read a second & third time (Carried)
It was read a second & third time according to the above
resolution.

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by
Jm. Wilson that the sum of fifty dollars
be expended by this Council on the Bridge
Commonly Known as Amstets bridge
provided that the Union forwarding Company
furnish a like sum to be expended on
the said bridge - Carried.

Moved by Dawson Elliott and
seconded by William Wilson that this
Council do now adjourn until the
last Saturday in April 1870 (Carried)

the following sums be expended on the several roads
hereafter mentioned viz. that the sum of \$40
be expended on Queen's road near Coffees Bridge
William Wallace Senr Commissioner for same.

That the sum of \$60⁰⁰ be expended on Queen's road
near Coffees Bridge Jm. Ross Commissioner
