

Minutes of the Court of Revision for the Township of Ross, for the year 1870

All the members of Court present

There were three complaints for investigation brought before the Court viz. that of Wm. Wright, James Little, and William Lett.

Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded by William Wilson that the amount assessed against James Little remain as assessed for 1870

Moved by John Hill and seconded by Dawson Elliott that all the personal property under one hundred dollars be struck off the roll for 1870 - Carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott & seconded by John Hill that William Wright's tax on personal property be struck off <sup>from the rolls for</sup> the year 1870 - Carried

Moved by John Hill & seconded by D. Elliott that the rolls now revised be and they are accepted as so revised, for the year 1870 Carried

Council Meeting 21<sup>st</sup> May 1870

The Council then commenced the general business of the Township - all the councillors present - the reeve in the chair.

Moved by John Hill & seconded by Dawson Elliott that an order be granted to Mr. Elliott for thirty dollars as part payment of his salary for 1870 - Carried

Moved by John Hill & seconded by Dawson Elliott that John Lee receive an order on Treasurer for fifty dollars for covering a bridge at Graff's Mill on Gould's line - Carried.

Moved by John Hill & seconded by Dawson Elliott that the sum of \$15.00 be expended between Cobden & the Township line leading to Oseola - Carried

Moved by John Hill, seconded by Dawson Elliott that John Reynolds receive an order on Treasurer for thirty dollars as part payment as assessor & collector for 1870 - Carried -

Moved by William Ross & seconded by William Wilson that the sum of \$12.00 be granted on the proving line between lots No 20 & 21 from the Government road to the Queen's road, - Carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by William Wilson that the clerk notify the County treasurer that the taxes on the West half of lot No 15 in the 1<sup>st</sup> Concession of Ross for the years 1868 & 1869 be struck off the Co, Treasurer's books as the same has been paid. Also that the taxes charged against lot No 11 in the 7<sup>th</sup> Concession for the year 1869 be also struck off as they are not due they having been charged on both rolls in a mistake - Carried

Moved by William Ross & seconded by William Wilson that this Council do now adjourn to meet again on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of August 1870 - Carried
