Minutes of former meeting read by the clerk and signed by the Reeve.

Moved by William Wilson seconded by William Ross that Robert Allen be, and he is hereby appointed a Commissioner to superintend the building of bridges & the repairs of Roads in this Township for this year 1870 - Carried

Moved by W<sup>m</sup> Wilson seconded by William Ross that Robert Allen be authorised to have built as soon as possible the bridges which have been burned by the late fire below Crastus Huntingtons - Carried

Moved by William Wilson seconded by W<sup>m</sup> Ross that the clerk notify the Norton Council of the dangerous state of the bridges at Mr. Cottons - Carried

Moved by William Wilson and seconded by William Ross that an order be drawn on the Treasurer in favour of John Reynolds for the sum of £6<sup>00</sup> for work done on the Government roads - Carried

Moved by William Ross & seconded by William Wilson that Levi Howard receive an order on Treasurer for the sum of \$1.50 for fighting fire at a bridge near James Jamiesons - Carried

Moved by William Ross and seconded by  
William Wilson that this Council do  
now adjourn to meet again on the last Saturday  
in October 1870 - Carried
