Bylaw for the purpose levying a tax to meet
the expenses of the Corporation for this year

Moved by William Ross that the clerk
notify Elias McQuade to leave the full
allowance of road on the 6th Concession
when he will be building his fences on said
road - Carried

Moved by Dawson Elliott seconded by
William Ross that Alex. Bell get permission
from this Council to perform two years
Statute labor on the Concession line
No 8 between lot No 7 in the 7th Cont

and the proving line leading from the
Government Road road to Lebolden (Carried)

Moved by Dawson Elliott Seconded by John
Hill that one Hundred dollars be expended
in the repairing of the bridge around the head
of Muskrat Lake (Carried)

Moved by William Ross Seconded by William Wilson
that this Council grant the sum of \$30⁰⁰ to be
expended on the Town line between the Muskrat
Lake and the Government Road (Lost)
