

Pursuant to notice duly published in the
Pembroke observer the Council of Pop sat as
a court of revision on 6th day of May 1871
There were two cases brought before the Court
viz one by Richd. Wats who shewed that the personal
property for which he was assessed on the rolls for
1871 was not paid for, & consequently not liable
to taxation. The Court ordered that \$100 dollars
of his (Wats) Personal property be struck off the rolls
The other Complaint was made by Richd. Humphries
who complained of overcharge on Rolls - The Court
ordered that \$50 dollars be struck off, as it
it was thought that his valuation was too high

Moved by Dawson Elliott and seconded by
Robert Reilly that the rolls be received as they
are fully revised for the year 1871

The Council then adjourned for one hour
for dinner after which they commenced the
general business of the Township - A full Council
being present. the Reeve in the chair.

Moved by William Ross & Seconded by Robert Reilly that this Council grant \$15 to be expended on the Town line opposite lot No 1 in the 2nd Concession of Ross - Carried

Moved by D. Elliott & Seconded by Robt Reilly that the clerk be authorized to notify Mr Thomas Kevell Michael Gorman Jun^r & Mr Gorman Sen^r, John Gorman, Patrick Dermott and all whom it may concern that they remove all fences from the Concession line between the 5th and 6th Concession - Carried

Moved by Robert Reilly & Seconded by Wm Ross that John Reynolds receive an order on the Treasurer for the sum of \$2⁰⁰ for polling both - Carried

Moved by William Ross & Seconded by Dawson Elliott that John Reynolds receive an order on Treasurer for \$30 for his services as assessor for 1871 as assessor - Carried

Moved by William Ross and Seconded by Robert Reilly that the clerk certify Philander Howard and George Freeland and David Rife that they leave the full allowance of road on the fourth and fifth Concession of Ross Also that Alexander Hudson George McEaster be notified in like manner

Moved by William Ross Seconded by Robert Reilly that this Council adjourn until the 1st Saturday in June 1871 - Carried
